

SoCal Yearbooks Workshop CODE OF CONDUCT

Attendance at SoCal Yearbooks Summer Workshop is a special privilege. Knowing that any such activity is judged by the behavior of its individual participants, the following guidelines are required for students attending these yearbook activities:

1. All students are expected to attend all sessions of the camp.
2. All students shall behave in a courteous and respectful manner, refraining from language and actions that might bring discredit upon either themselves, their school, or the camp.
3. Evening curfew times are listed in the agenda. Curfew is defined as being in your designated sleeping room with a minimal amount of noise, and being respectful to others in a group living arrangement. Nightly routines such as showers, etc., should be taken care of prior to lights out.
4. Because camp attendees are guests of these facilities, care should be taken not to destroy or deface property. Any such damages must be paid for by that individual.
5. For emergency reasons, students will sleep in their designated rooms only. No room switching is allowed.
6. Separate accommodations have been provided for the males and females. At no time is a female student allowed in a male's dorm room; at no time is a male student allowed in a female's dorm room. If this rule is violated your parents will be contacted and you will be asked to leave. While working in school groups, schools may meet in the student lounge/study areas only.
7. Students must remain on campus during their entire SoCal Yearbooks experience. Any Student found off campus at any time will have their parents contacted and be sent home. Commuters are the exception.
8. No alcoholic beverages or drugs in any form shall be possessed or used at any time or under any circumstance. Cigarette smoking is discouraged, but allowed only in designated areas by students of legal smoking age. Positively no smoking is allowed in dorm facilities. It is prohibited within 20 feet of any buildings on campus.
9. A re-keying charge of \$50.00 will be assessed to any students who lose their dorm card key. Lost meal cards are \$25.00 to replace.
